



Supporting Your Program



BJA POLICY TEAM

Develops grant programs and directs technical assistance to meet grantee needs and advance the field's public safety goals.

BJA PROGRAMS TEAM

Grant monitoring and administration assistance to ensure success and compliance. Primary point of contact on administrative issues. **BJA PPI TEAM**

Sets program goals and collects performance measures data to assess achievement of those goals. All BJA grantees collect and report performance data.

TTA PROVIDER

Works with individual grantees to assure comprehensive BWC polices are in place, provide customized TTA, and develop knowledge products.

• **Body-worn cameras, policies and procedures: "**In accepting this award, the recipient agrees not to use award funds for purchases of body-worn cameras or related expenses for any agency unless that agency has policies and procedures in place that reinforce appropriate agency use of force policies and training and address technology usage, evidence acquisition, data storage and retention, as well as privacy issues, accountability and discipline."



Next 30 Days

Have initial virtual meeting with TTA provider

Begin process of having BWC policy special condition addressed

Develop a schedule for regular meetings and establish appropriate agency representatives to be part of those meetings

Work with TTA provider to identify individual needs to be addressed



Next 60 Days

Finalize BWC policy special condition fulfillment

Share the policy with TTA provider

Continue regular meeting with TTA provider

Submit first PPI reports reflecting performance measurement for the first six months of your award.
