#### What is Training & Technical Assistance (TTA)?


Ensure success in reducing violence

- Listen and assist you with overcoming challenges and issues.



























#### **Problem-Oriented Policing Strategy**


Herman Goldstein is the father of problem-solving

#### ASSESSMENT

evaluate the effectiveness of the response



#### RESPONSE

identify and select interventions; develop and implement an action plan



#### SCANNING

identify and prioritize the problem




#### ANALYSIS


use relevant data to pinpoint root causes of the problem
